

ANALYSIS OF MOTIVATION IN THE NOVEL CINTAMU SELUAS SAMUDERA BY GOLA GONG AND ITS IMPLICATIONS FOR LEARNING INDONESIAN LANGUAGE IN SMA

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Abstrak: Motivasi timbul ketika ada dorongan dari dalam maupun luar diri seseorang sehingga terjadi perubahan sikap untuk melakukan sesuatu yang diinginkan atau dikehendaki. Motivasi sendiri dapat disalurkan melalui sebuah karya sastra. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis aspek motivasi dalam novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* karya Gola Gong serta implikasinya terhadap pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia di SMA. Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini, yaitu metode deskriptif kualitatif, artinya data yang ditemukan berupa kata-kata dan hasilnya akan dipaparkan secara deskriptif. Data yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini berupa kutipan novel yang berjudul *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* karya Gola Gong. Sumber data yang digunakan dalam penulisan ini adalah sumber data primer yaitu berupa teks dari novel yang berjudul *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* karya Gola Gong yang diterbitkan oleh penerbit pada tahun 2008. Teknik pengumpulan data pada penelitian ini dilakukan teknik catat. Pengecekan keabsahan data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan metode triangulasi. Analisis motivasi yang menjadi fokus penelitian, adalah motivasi internal dan eksternal. Yang termasuk motivasi internal yaitu harga diri dan prestasi, harapan dan kebutuhan, sedangkan motivasi eksternal yaitu situasi lingkungan pada umumnya. Dari hasil penelitian tersebut ditemukan data sebanyak 57 temuan data. Dengan mencermati analisis aspek motivasi tersebut dapat diketahui bahwa motivasi harapan merupakan temuan paling banyak dalam analisis ini, sedangkan tiga bentuk aspek motivasi yang lainnya ditemukan data yang beragam. Hasil ini memberikan hal yang positif bagi pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia di SMA.

ABSTRACT: Motivation arises when there is encouragement from within and outside a person so that there is a change in attitude to do something that is desired or desired. Motivation itself can be channeled through a literary work. This study aims to Analysis Of Motivation in the novel *Love As Wide As The Ocean* By Gola Gong And Its Implications For Learning Indonesia In High School. The method used in this research is descriptive qualitative method, meaning that the data found are in the form of words and the results will be presented descriptively. The data used in this study are excerpts from the novel entitled *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong. The data source used in this paper is the primary data source in the form of text from the novel entitled *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong which was published by the publisher in 2008. The technique of collecting data in this study was a note-taking technique. Checking the validity of the data in this study using the triangulation method. The analysis of motivation which is the focus of the research is internal and external motivation. Which includes internal motivation, namely self-esteem and achievement, expectations and needs, while motivation external, namely the environmental situation in general. From the results of the study, it was found that there were 57 data findings. By looking at the analysis of the motivational aspect, it can be seen that the motivation of hope is the most common finding in this analysis, while the other three forms of motivational aspects are found to be varied in data. These results provide a positive thing for learning Indonesian in high school.

I. INTRODUCTION

Every individual has a desire or ambition to satisfy the determination he wants to realize. This ambition can be achieved because it is influenced by motivation. Motivation affects changes that occur in individuals that appear in changes in attitudes as well as feelings and emotions, so that it can encourage someone to do an act due to a desire or goal to be achieved. Without the presence of motivation, a person will not be moved to start behavior because there is no emergence of determination to achieve all of his targets.

Reading a novel must be based on motivation. Motivation arises when there is encouragement from within and outside a person so that there is a change in attitude to do something that is desired or desired. Motivation

will arise when an individual is very enthusiastic to do certain activities or do something he wants. Motivation also arises when an individual has a desire or goal to achieve something in order to get satisfaction so that it is clearly related to the psyche of a person, for example from the feelings or emotions he shows. After reading a novel, students not only get motivated to read, but apart from that, students can reflect on their own lives. Students can also get internal and external motivation so that they can motivate themselves in doing positive things. Positive motivation will produce a success that will satisfy the individual.

Motivation is very important for a person to live his life, someone wants to work hard because of the motivation, and is eager to get the results he wants. Every action taken by humans is always based on motivation. While

the occurrence of motivation because there is a process of internal and external encouragement that greatly affects a change in a person so that the spirit appears to be able to meet the desired target.

Indonesian language learning in schools, especially high schools, should involve students' activeness in learning the contents of the novel. Student activity in the learning process is very important because it can be a measure of how much enthusiasm and curiosity students have for novels. Students will get the experience of thinking scientifically and this will help students to express well and grow into whole human beings. In connection with the above, students are required to actively read, observe and understand their own novels that are used as learning materials. then students will begin to actively study a novel.

In this case, students are expected to be able to enjoy the beauty of a literary work by knowing and understanding each of the building blocks of a literary work and students can take positive values from a novel they have read. The implication for learning Indonesian in high school is to gain knowledge about the motivations contained in the novel, so students have found the motivational aspects contained in the novel, because learning novels in Indonesian plays an important role in shaping the personality of students, especially in high school students.

Based on the description above, the researchers chose to analyze the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong with the title: *Analysis of Motivation in the Novel Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong and its implications for learning Indonesian in high school.

II. RESEARCH METHODS

Method is a way or strategy used to understand reality, and steps systematically so that it can solve a series of causes and effects. The method serves to make the problems studied in the study easier to solve and understand. In addition, research must also have methods and steps that are used appropriately, and in accordance with the object of study to be studied.

In this study of motivational aspects, the method used is a qualitative method. Qualitative method is a research that is intended to describe and analyze phenomena, events, social activities, attitudes, beliefs, perceptions, and thoughts of people individually or in groups. Qualitative descriptive method is used as a method of describing the problem by describing the situation of the object of research in the form of a novel. This research method includes data collection methods, data analysis, and data inference.

Based on the explanation above, it can be concluded that qualitative research is research that intends to understand phenomena about what is experienced by research subjects. One of the characteristics of qualitative research is people as data collectors. Qualitative research is always descriptive, meaning that the data analyzed and the results of the analysis are in the form of descriptions, not numbers.

The data in this study are in the form of excerpts from the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong. The primary data source in this writing is in the form of text

from a novel entitled *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong which was published by a publisher in 2008.

In this study, the technique of collecting data was using a note-taking technique. Data were collected through in-depth and intensive reading activities. The procedure for collecting data is through observing the motivational aspects contained in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong.

The steps taken by researchers in collecting data are as follows:

- 1) Read critically the entire text of the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong.
- 2) Record data in the form of quotes, and relevant conversations related to the motivational aspects in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong.
- 3) Classification of data, at this stage is carried out after data collection is completed by classifying data based on what is in the research instrument.

In this study, researchers used data triangulation. Data collection that also tests the credibility of the data, namely checking the credibility of the data with various data collection techniques and as a data source.

According to Patton (in Moleong, 2015:331) suggests that there are four kinds of triangulators that can be used in research including:

1. Triangulation of sources, namely checking sources that utilize different types of data sources to explore similar data.
2. Triangulation method is an examination that emphasizes the use of different data collection methods and even types to be attempted to lead to the same data source to test the stability of the information.
3. Research triangulation, namely the results of both the above research or conclusions regarding certain parts or the whole can be tested for validity from several other researchers.
4. Theory triangulation, namely examining data using the perspective of more than one theory in discussing the problems studied.

The triangulation used in this study is source triangulation, where the source examination utilizes different types of data sources to explore similar data. The researcher triangulated sources including primary data, in this writing in the form of text from a novel entitled *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong.

Therefore, the researcher held a discussion with three triangulators, each of whom had competence in the Indonesian language. The triangulator of this research, namely:

Data analysis is the process of systematically searching and compiling data that has been obtained from interviews, and field notes, so that it can be easily understood, and the findings can be informed to others. There are several stages that the researchers did.

1) Data collection

Read carefully the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong to find and record data in the form of quotes that contain motivation in aspects: internal motivation, individual perception of himself, self-esteem and achievement, expectations, needs, and external motivation, type and nature of work, work group, the general environmental situation and the system of rewards received.

2) Data reduction

The data obtained from data collection is then reduced to select and classified the data needed in the study which contains components of motivational aspects in aspects: internal motivation, individual perception of himself, self-esteem and achievement, expectations, needs, and external motivation, type and nature of work, work group, the general environmental situation and the system of rewards received.

3) Data presentation

At this stage the researcher moved the data that had been previously reduced into the specification tables contained in the research instrument. Then perform an analysis of the data based on the motivational aspect in the following aspects: internal motivation, individual perception of himself, self-esteem and achievement, expectations, needs, and external motivation, type and nature of work, work group, environmental situation in general and the reward system received.

4) Drawing conclusions

At the stage of drawing conclusions from the categories that have been collected and reduced and presented for further conclusions regarding the answers to the formulation and sub-focus of research problems concerning aspects of motivation in aspects: internal motivation, individual perceptions of themselves, self-esteem and achievement, expectations, needs, and external motivations the type and nature of the work, work group, general environmental situation and reward system received.

The stages of research conducted by researchers consist of three stages as follows:

1) Early stages of research

Read carefully the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong to find and record data in the form of quotes containing motivation which will be investigated by the author.

2) Research implementation stage

a. Analyzing the text of the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong.

b. Quoting the text of the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong which has been analyzed and transferred to a table.

c. Check the validity of the data carried out by the triangulator.

d. The researcher compiles each chapter, and submits it to the supervisor to get input so that the research is directed and correct, then to get an assessment.

3) Completion stage

Every direction and input from the supervisor is accepted and followed by the researcher so that he can complete the final research with good results.

III. RESULT DISCUSSION

The data that has been collected in this study, namely 57 quotations in which there are aspects of internal and external motivation. In this table, the researcher analyzes the sentences or words in the quote from the novel *Cintamu Secepat Samudra* by Gola Gong which contains aspects of internal and external motivation which include aspects of internal motivation including: aspects of internal motivation, self-esteem and achievement, expectations, needs, and external motivation of the situation. environment in general.

The discussion of the findings is used by researchers to describe the results of data analysis regarding the motivational aspects contained in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong. In this study, researchers focused on four aspects of motivation consisting of internal and external motivation. In this study, there were 57 quotations containing aspects of internal motivation, self-esteem and achievement, aspects of

internal motivation, expectations and aspects of external motivation, namely the environmental situation in general. The discussion of the findings will be described one by one based on the order of the data in the data findings table.

1. Internal Motivation Aspect

Motivation is an active energy that causes a change in a person to act or do actions that are influenced by the desires, needs and goals to be satisfied so that it appears in psychological symptoms, feelings and emotions.

1.1 Internal Motivation Self-Esteem and Achievement

Self-esteem can also greatly affect an individual's achievement because of the desire to feel that his abilities are meaningful, valued, and recognized so that it will encourage someone to excel in academic and non-academic fields. This is contained in the following data.

Data No. 4

Quote: "He is a young doctor in his college, Anah graduated with the best honors. Several companies are trying to take him to become a clinical doctor." (Page 121)

Analysis: In the quote of data no. 4 "She is a young doctor at her campus, Anah graduated with the best predicate" shows that Siti Nurkhasanah has self-esteem that causes the motivation to become a doctor. In addition, motivational impulses arise in a person or individual because of their achievements in order to achieve the goals they want to achieve, such as Siti Nurkhasanah who excels so that she can become the best graduate in her campus. The impulse that arises from within Siti Nurkhasanah is called the internal motivation of self-esteem and achievement.

1.2 Internal Motivation Expectations

A person's motivation arises because of their hopes for the future. The existence of hope in a person, then arises the desire and even the ideals that must be achieved in the future. A person must have motivation so that the behavior or actions taken can realize the desired expectations. This is contained in the following data.

quote: "We will definitely meet again, dear, Natali looks resigned. Trust Mama, we will definitely meet again, while crying, she handed the baby basket containing her baby to Bulloh". (Page 17)

Analysis: In data no. 7 "Believe in Mama, we will definitely meet again" shows that Natalia is trying to convince the child she will throw away that one day they will definitely meet again. The encouragement of hope in the future motivates Natalia to keep looking for her child and she always hopes to find her child again even though it takes quite a long time. The urge that comes from within Natalia is what is called the internal motivation of hope.

1.3 Internal Motivation Needs

Needs motivate a person to achieve the ability to be able to sustain life and to obtain welfare and even comfort. The need will encourage a person's behavior to look for everything needed to grow motivation for something,

because with a need, someone will try their best to fulfill it.

Quote: "In his house there is a wife and two children that he must support. If he refuses his employer's orders, he will definitely be kicked out and someone else will replace his position as a driver! means, it's the apocalypse for him! He doesn't want to imagine the bitter fate of a husband without a job!" (Page 17)

Analysis: Data 44 "In his house there is a wife and two children who must be supported" shows that Bulloh has a need that motivates Bulloh to work hard for his family. He is motivated to meet the needs of his family at home is absolutely essential that humans must meet for their survival. If Bulloh does not do the work ordered by his employer then he will be fired from his job as a driver, if that happens then he and his family will not eat. This need is the impetus for Bulloh to work hard. The impulse that arises from within Bulloh is called the internal motivation of needs.

2.1 External Motivation Environmental Situation in General

The social environment of society generally affects an individual. The influence occurs because of the existence of a person in a society which includes the activities of individuals in that society, friends to hang out with, the mass media and in the form of people's lives. In addition, the social environment of the family also has an effect on causing motivation in a person.

Quote: "You have to go to school, Anah. You have to be smart. Must be a graduate so that our degrees are raised. I don't want you, later you will become a rice uduk seller like my mother. You have to change fate." (Page 32)

Analysis: On data 49 "You have to go to school, Anah. You have to be smart. You have to become a scholar so that your degree will be raised", proving that there is an environmental situation that encourages Siti Nurkhasanah to take some action. Her mother told Siti Nurkhasanah to study seriously so that she could uphold and raise her degree his family. This is what makes Siti Nurkhasanah motivated to study and go to college, so that motivation includes external motivation.

IV. CONCLUSION

Based on the results of the analysis of motivational aspects in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong and its implications for learning Indonesian in high school, the conclusions are as follows:

1. Analysis of motivational aspects in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong, there are 57 findings of data on motivational aspects consisting of internal and external motivation. Aspects of internal motivation, self-esteem and achievement as many as 6 data findings, internal motivation expectations as many as 35 data findings, and internal motivation needs as many as 5 data findings. While the external motivation aspect of the environmental situation in general is 11 data findings. Thus, in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong, there are internal motivations for

self-esteem and achievement, internal motivations for expectations, internal motivations for needs and aspects of external motivation, namely the environmental situation in general.

2. Based on the data from the analysis of the motivational aspect of the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong, there are many aspects of motivation, namely the internal motivation aspect of hope, which has 35 data findings, while the motivational aspect that appears the least is the internal motivation of needs as many as 5 data findings. Thus, of the four aspects of motivation contained in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong, most of them contain motivational aspects.

3. The novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong can be used as teaching material in learning Indonesian in high school, especially in class XII. The motivational aspect contained in the novel *Cintamu Seluas Samudra* by Gola Gong can be a good input for teachers in appreciating literary works. In addition, the use of motivational aspects can increase knowledge theoretically and can apply good motivational aspects in appreciating literary works.
